

Effort to Gain Control of Government Predicted Late This Winter or Early Spring.

Gold Receipts Are Heaviest Since
1917, While Silver Consignments
Continue Relatively Small.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 27. — Exports during October increased by nearly \$100,000,000, while imports declined approximately \$1,000,000. Foreign trade figures made public today by the department of commerce show Exports were valued at \$752,000,000 against \$695,900,000 in September and imports were valued at \$310,000,000 against \$311,000,000. The excess of exports over imports in October, amounting to \$442,000,000, is the largest in any month of the present year.

For the 10 months ended with October exports were valued at \$6,832,000,000 against \$6,482,000,000 compared with \$6,498,000,000 for the same period last year, and imports were valued at \$3,120,000,000, or \$1,621,000,000 less than for the same period last year.

more than during the same period last year. Thus the trade balance in favor of the United States for the 10 months of this year is \$112,000,000, compared with a balance for the same period the year before of \$3,400,000,000.

Imports of gold during October were the largest in three years, amounting to \$117,000,000, as compared with \$100,000,000 in September and \$5,000,000 in October last year. For the 10-months' period, gold imports amounted to \$1,117,000,000, or \$1,361,000,000 in the same period of 1919. Gold exports in October were \$1,000,000,000, as compared with \$1,000,000,000 in September and for the 10 months ended with October exports of gold amounted to \$10,000,000,000, or \$12,700,000,000 for the same period last year.

Trade in silver remains relatively small, the statement said. Imports for the 10 months ended with October were \$78,000,000 against \$75,000,000 for the corresponding period of 1919, as compared with \$159,000,000 for the corresponding period last year. The figure for October was not given.
