

MACSWINEY'S WIDOW IN U. S. TO AID IRISH

Crowd Escorts Visitor From
Pier Through Streets.

THROUGHS GATHER AT DAWN

Wives of New York Mayor and Gov-
ernor on Reception Commit-
tee of Women.

NEW YORK, Dec. 4.—Welcomed by shouts of a crowd, who after her landing formed a parade and escorted her through the streets to her hotel, Mrs. Muriel MacSwiney, widow of Terence MacSwiney, former lord mayor of Cork, arrived today to assist others of her countrymen working in America for the cause of Irish independence.

Scenes which marked the reception accorded her were colorful and dramatic.

At earliest dawn hundreds began making their way to the pier where the liner Celtic was to dock, while harbor craft steamed out to quarantine for a first glimpse of the pale and dignified appearing young woman.

Greeted by a committee of five women, including the wives of the governor and mayor, who were permitted to board the vessel, Mrs. MacSwiney and her sister-in-law, Miss Mary MacSwiney, stepped onto the dock to be received by Harry Boland, secretary to Eamonn De Valera, president of the Irish republic, and other prominent Irish.

The party then made its way to the street, accepted the homage of the crowd who waved flags and sang American and Irish songs, and then in a taxicab headed the procession up Fifth avenue to the hotel.

Beyond a short expression of thanks for her warm reception, Mrs. MacSwiney made no statement. She will be in Washington Wednesday to appear before the committee of 100 investigating Irish affairs.

The staid club has reached Twenty-third street, seven blocks from the pier, before it was halted, and the welcome fell into line. A band struck up with the Irish Spangled Banner and the "Irish republic" airs, cheers were raised and the parade got under way.

The city officially welcomed Mrs. MacSwiney through Grover A. Whelan, commissioner of parks and structures, representing Mayor Hylan. Down the bay J. L. Fawcett, "Irish consul" at New York, and a personal representative of Eamonn De Valera, president of the "Irish republic," accompanied by Oswald Garrison Villard of the committee of 100, met Mrs. MacSwiney going out to the Celtic on the coast guard cutter which put customs and newspaper men aboard the liner.

The police boats Patrol and John F. Hylan carried welcoming delegations down the bay with representatives of a number of organizations of Irish sympathizers to meet the Celtic. Mrs. Peter MacSwiney and Mrs. Annie MacSwiney, Diney's cousin, of Mrs. MacSwiney, shouted a welcome from the Patrol.

Mrs. MacSwiney expressed gratification at the "wonderful" reception given her. She said she was happy to be in a country where so many people are thinking about the cause of Ireland.

"Both my husband and I always expected that America would help us in winning our freedom," she said. "We feel in Ireland that America has a greater responsibility in the matter than any other land on account of her fine traditions and her war pledges and because there are so many millions of our kin in this country."

Mrs. MacSwiney said she could not discuss conditions in Ireland until she had appeared before the committee of 100. She said she expected to testify in Washington next Wednesday.

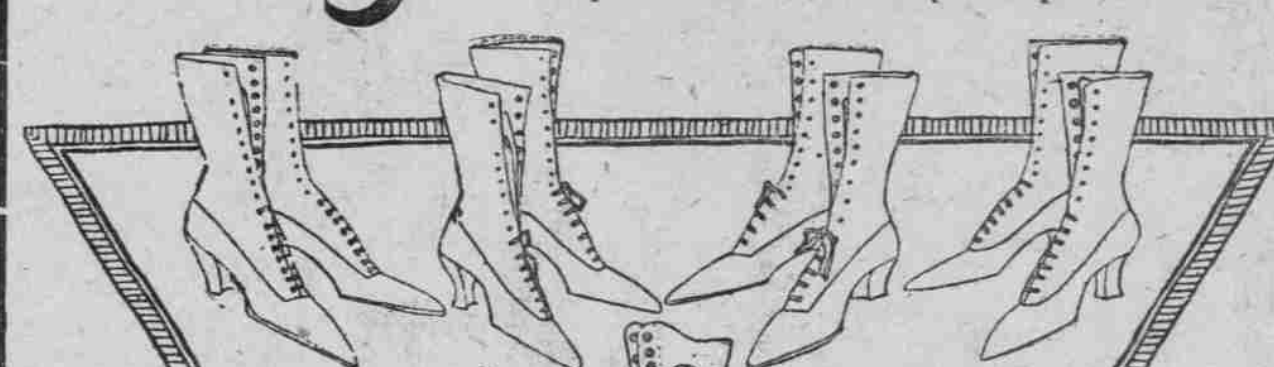

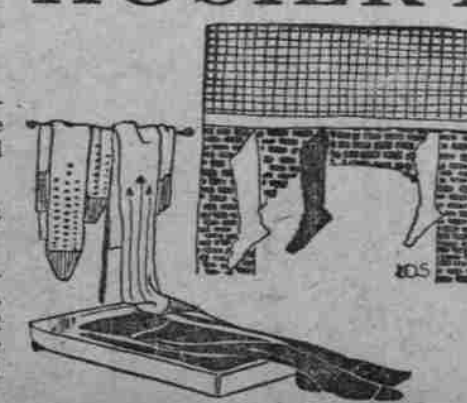
