President Wilson, Although Retiring From Public Life, Will Continue to Take Active Interest in Affairs of Nation, Says Tumulty.

WASHINGTON, D. C., Feb. 12.—President Wilson will seek rest and quiet for a time upon his retirement from public life next month, but he will continue to take an active interest in public affairs, his secretary, Joseph P. Tumulty, said the other day.
