

STILLMAN ACCUSED OF WITNESS BRIBING

Two Alleged Perjurers Named in Divorce Court.

MONTREAL HEARING IS UP

Commission Promised to Take Testimony in Canada Beginning January 11.

POUGHKEEPSIE, N. Y., Dec. 10.—(By the Associated Press.)—Accusations that two Canadians had been bribed to testify against Mrs. Anne U. Stillman and that agents for James A. Stillman attempted to corrupt 11 others into giving false testimony opened a fresh counter-attack today on the banker in his divorce suit.

The charges were made in open court before Supreme Court Justice Moreschini by J. P. Brennan, chief of Mrs. Stillman's counsel, and John E. Mack, guardian ad litem for her three-year-old son, Guy, whose legitimacy the banker impugned. Mr. Brennan presented an affidavit signed by himself outlining the allegations and explaining that they would be borne out by the testimony of witnesses to be called at Montreal beginning January 11.

The testimony in connection with which the charges were made was that Mrs. Stillman violated her marriage vow in her conduct with Fred Beauvais, Indiana guide, accused by the banker of being the father of Guy.

Witnesses Are Named. Mr. Brennan's affidavit named several witnesses who, he said, would be called to testify that agents of Mr. Stillman attempted to bribe them in 1920, about the time the banker instituted the divorce suit.

The affidavit named Joseph and Ferdinand Page, both of Lawrence, Que., as the two who were bribed before testifying against Mrs. Stillman. Mr. Brennan told the banker's lawyer, Outbridge Hovey, that agents for Mr. Stillman who sought to corrupt witnesses were J. Albert La Fontaine and Francois La Jolie, and added that there were others who were guilty.

Eleven witnesses named in the affidavit would, Mr. Brennan stated, swear that agents for Mr. Stillman sought to bribe them "with considerable sums of money if they would falsely swear they witnessed misconduct by Beauvais and Mrs. Stillman."

Misconduct Is Charged. The affidavit renewed charges that Mr. Stillman was guilty of misconduct with three women, Florence H. Leeds, and two identified only as "Helen" and "Clara."

After short debate between counsel Justice Moreschini granted the application to shift the trial to Montreal at an open commission to begin sessions January 11, the commissioner to be appointed shortly.

This will be the first time since the beginning of the trials that hearings have been public.
