MRS. CHARLES DILLINGHAM of New York, wife of the famed theatrical producer, is reputed to have caught the largest fish ever hooked in southern waters—a tarpon weighing 128 pounds.

A rare photograph has recently been discovered which shows former King Edward VII and Queen Alexandra in their wedding robes. The present King George V is their son. Queen Alexandra is now the queen mother of England, King Edward having died in 1910.

Miss Wilmuth Gary, known as "The International Betsy Ross," recently presented to President Harding her flag of nations. She designed and made it with her own hands. It required three months to complete it.

Miss Maude Royden is the first woman preacher to receive sanction of the Church of England. She is in the United States to study conditions and to speak at Y. W. C. A. conventions. She has expressed approval of the American "flap-

per," says it is yet too early to give an opinion on American prohibition and that it is too soon to introduce it in Great Britain.

Mrs. John Jacob Rogers, wife of Representative Rogers, was recently named by President Harding to make an investigation of conditions in certain soldier hospitals. 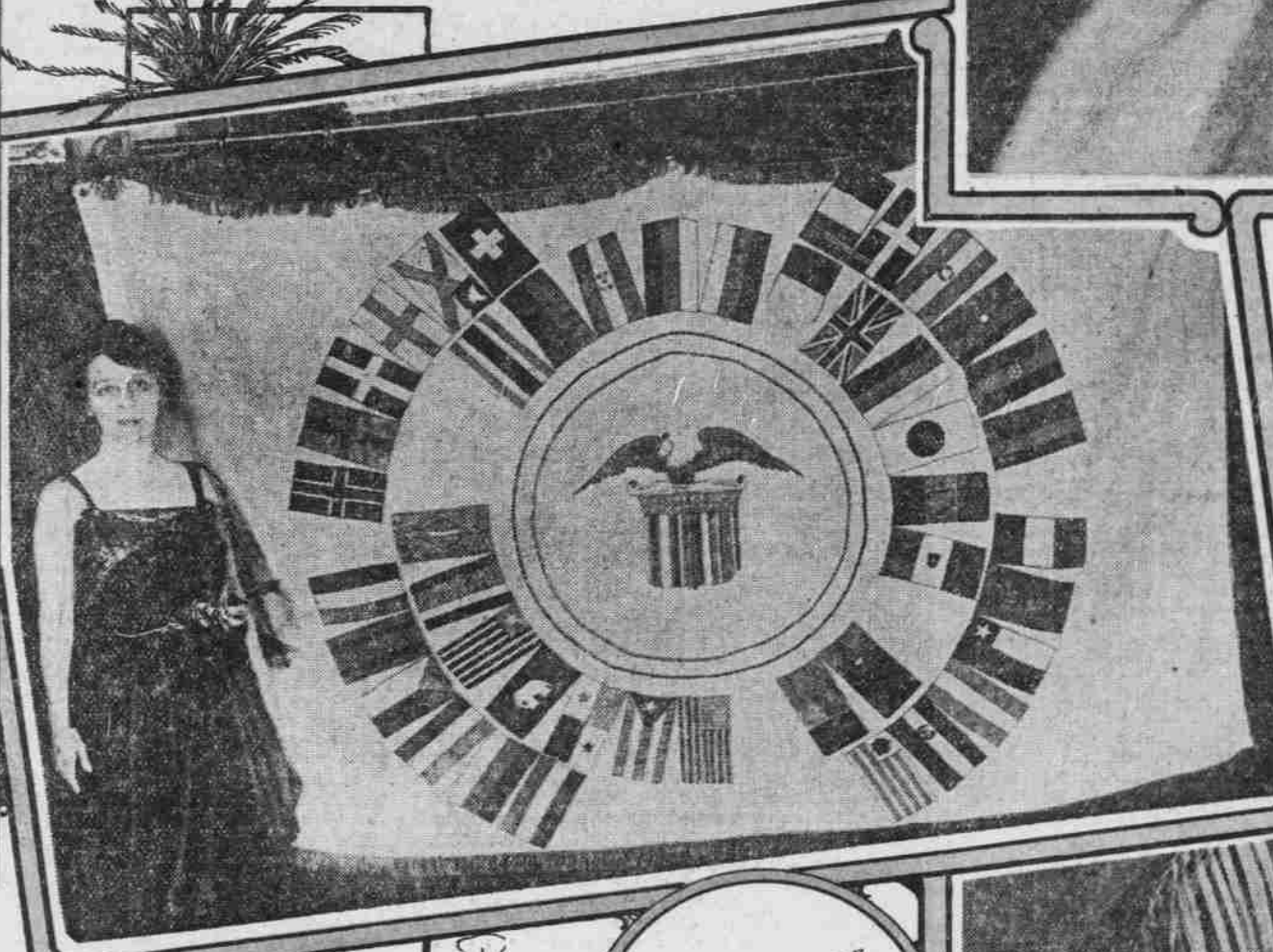
