

HALL AND OLCOTT ARE NECK AND NECK

Governor Only Nine Behind in Count So Far

MISSING TOTAL IS SMALL

General Outside Trend is Governor and Odds Seem to Favor Nomination

that from now on the new totals will favor Olcott.

The figures which make up these totals are complete for Clatsop, Columbia, Hood River, Josephine, Lane, Wasco, Washington, Yamhill, Benton, Marion, Morrow, Multnomah, Polk, Wheeler and official from Sherman. From four or five other counties in western Oregon only a few scattering precincts are to be returned.

The contender in third place is L. L. Patterson with 11,332. White is fourth with 8,523, Ryan fifth with 8,221 and Lee last with 2,103.

Figures similar as regards completeness show that Eugene Olcott has been elected over O. H. Fithian as republican national committeeman by more than 10,000 majority. Williams has also won by a majority of 1832, but has a lead in nearly every other county in the state.

W. C. Hawley, in the 1st district, and N. J. Sinnott in the 2d, have been renominated for congress, as has C. N. McArthur in the 3d.

Sinnott's Majority Over Gwinn in his district of about 2500, while Hawley leads Norblad in his district by nearly 9000.

Thomas F. Ryan has dropped definitely out of the contest for state treasurer with a total lead in Multnomah county in favor of O. P. Huff of nearly 9000 against Ryan's lead in the other counties of less than 4000.

For closeness the contest between Thomas K. Campbell and J. T. Thiehooff for public service commissioner is as striking as that between the leading candidates for governor. In the present returns Campbell has a lead over Thiehooff of 75. Returns on this office, however, are less complete than those on governor. The tendency in the up-state vote gives Campbell generally the better of the race and as he has already overcome a Multnomah majority of more than 5000 votes in favor of Thiehooff, it is probable that he has been nominated.

Dalaii Beaten by Gram. C. H. Gram has, on the face of the returns, defeated W. A. Dalaii for labor commissioner. The strength of the latter was greatest in Multnomah county, which he carried by nearly 2500 majority, but Gram ran the better in the state at large and has a present majority of 2342.

Patterson, republican candidate for county treasurer, unopposed, who was the recipient of 1832 votes. Wasco county expressed itself emphatically on the question of recall of Public Service Commissioner Williams, casting 1111 votes for his recall, compared with 576 against.
