Section A. Single rose display. To be exhibited in vases. Class 1—Best bloom from the garden. Not more than one rose shall be exhibited from any one garden or by one exhibitor.

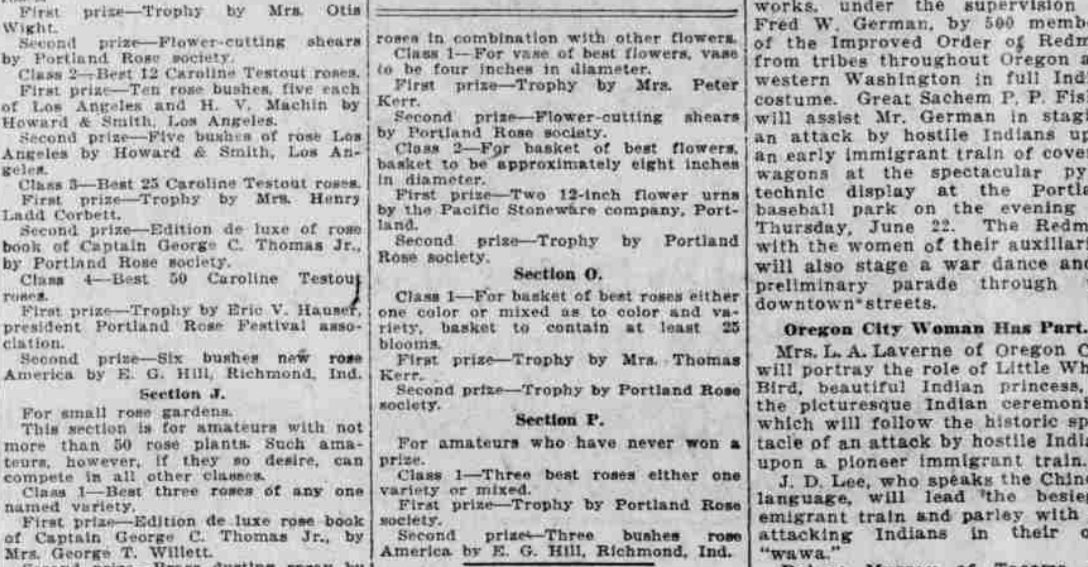
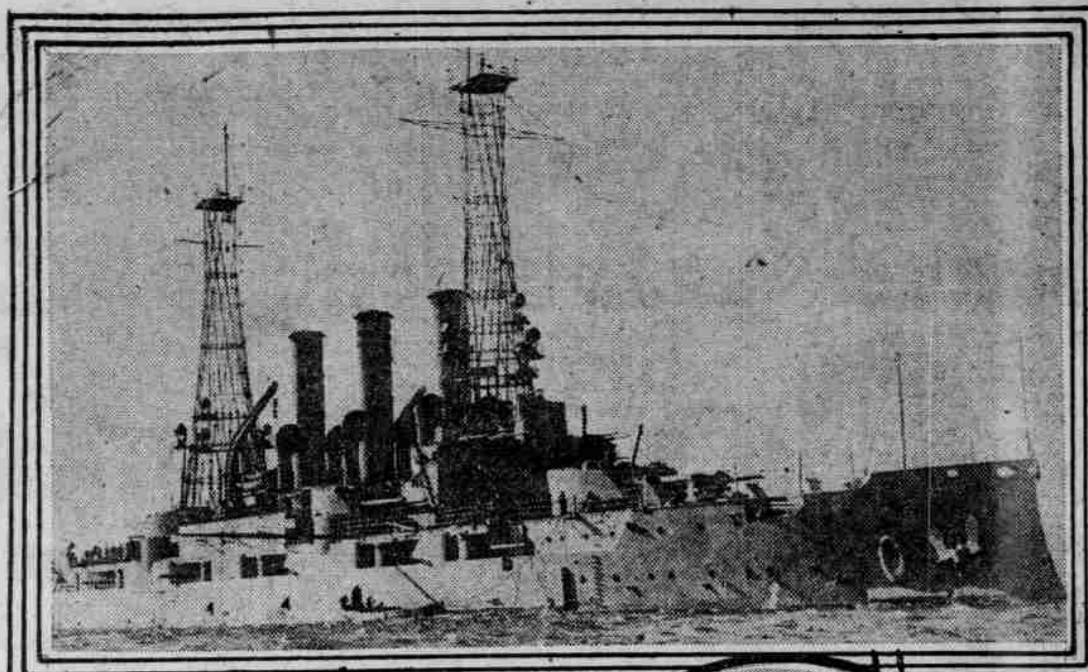
Section B. Specimen blooms. To be exhibited in individual boxes. Class 1—Six best, separate named varieties. Class 2—Twelve best roses, separate named varieties.

Section C. Basket of roses. To be exhibited in baskets which will be furnished by the society. Exhibitors desiring to use own baskets can do so, but the society will not be responsible for each private property.

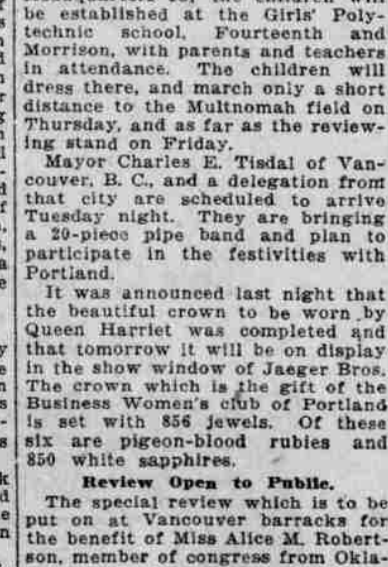
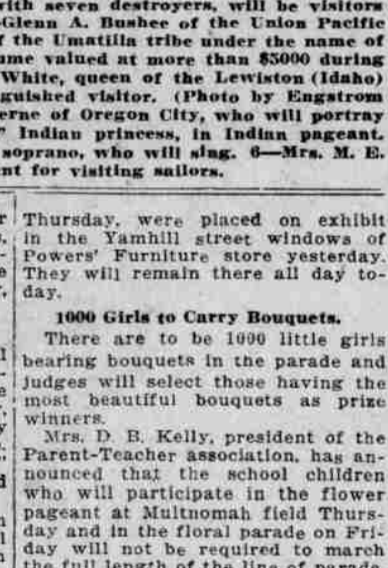
Section D. Climbing and rambling roses. To be exhibited in vases or baskets. Class 1—Best display of not less than six and not more than 12 sprays of any one named variety of climbing or pillar rose.

Section E. Single, decorative and miniature roses. To be exhibited in vases or baskets. Class 1—Best display of decorative roses of any one named variety.

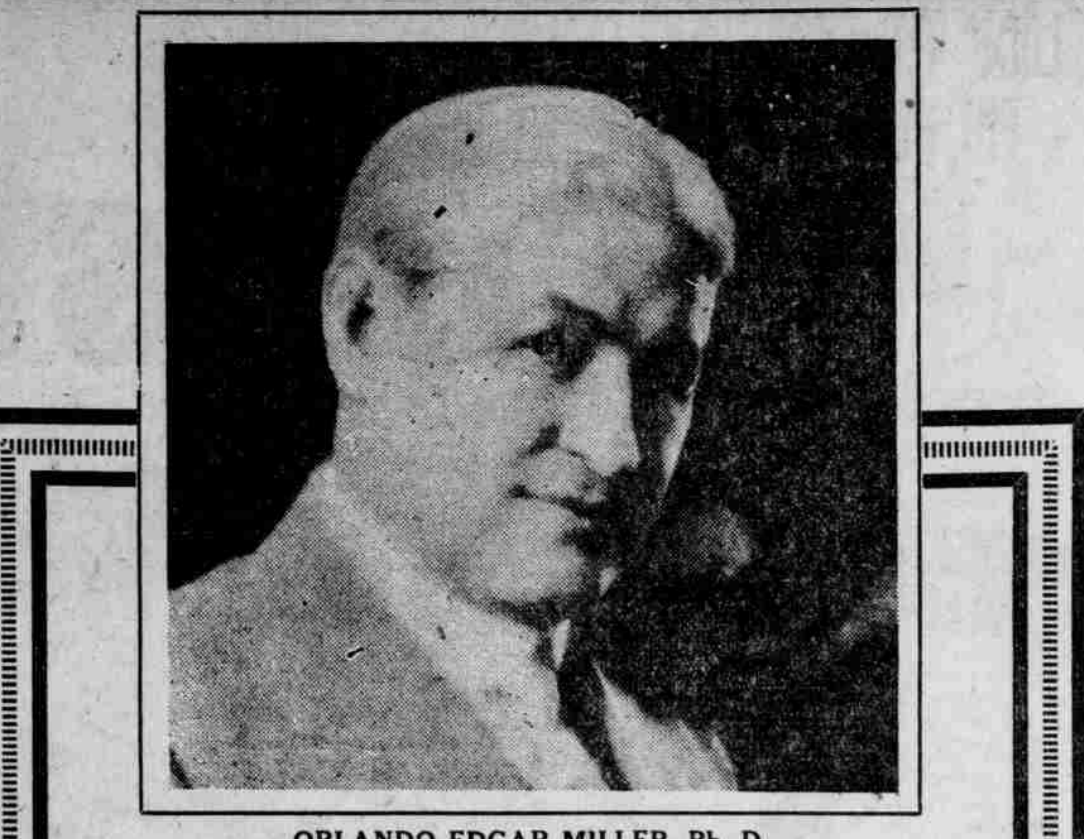
