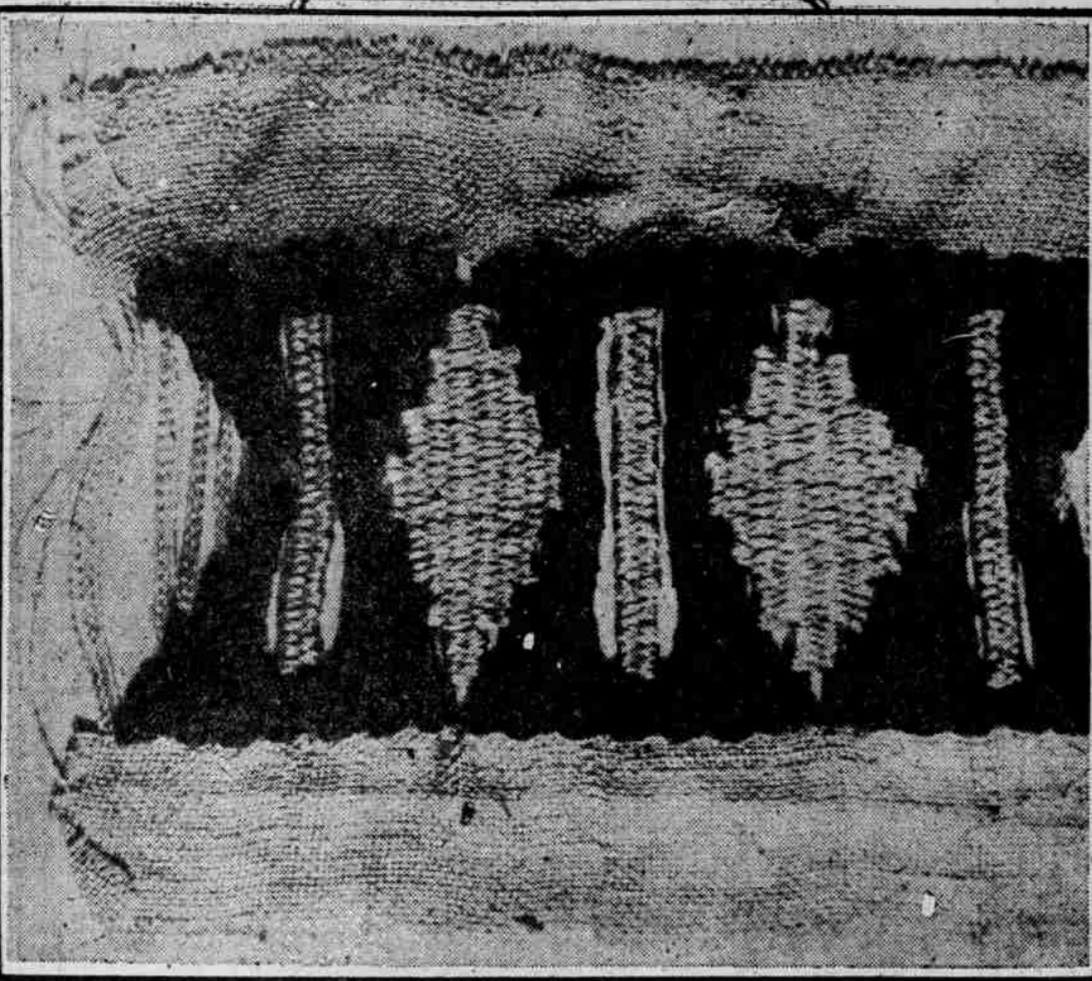


SWEDISH WEAVING FASCINATING KIND OF DRAWNWORK, UTILIZING DARNING STITCH

Embroidery Hoops, Blunt Needle and Silk Strand Embroidery Cotton Are Requisites—Work Is Decorative on Fine Towels—Many Delightful Designs Are Possible.

 SWEDISH weaving is a fascinating kind of drawn work, and is not difficult, the darning or weaving stitch being used. Embroidery hoops, a blunt needle, and six strand embroidery cotton are the necessary materials for the work besides, of course, the linen on which the work is to be done. It is decorative on fine towels, and there are many delightful designs—one of which is shown here.

Design Worked in Linen.
 This design was worked on an 800 linen, in blue and yellow. If it is to be used on a towel, pull the first thread three inches from one edge, then baste the number of threads taken up depending upon the coarseness or fineness of the linen. Hemstitching is not absolutely necessary for a start, but makes a good foundation for the weaving. The beauty of this work depends a great deal on weaving the stitches as closely together as possible, without having a drawn look. The design shown here measures one and a half inches in width, done on a linen of medium weight. The directions follow:

Four Threads in Each Group.
 Each group consists of four threads. Stretch the material in the hoops after drawing the threads for about two inches. Begin at the left, and count off 14 groups. With blue thread weave under and over the 14 groups for one-ninth the entire distance or length of the threads.

Drop one group at the left and eight groups at the right, and weave under and over the five groups for one-ninth the entire length of the threads. Drop one group at the left and weave under and over the remaining groups for one-ninth the entire length of the threads. Again, drop one group at the left and weave under and over the two groups for one-ninth the entire distance of the threads. Pick up one group of threads at the right, and weave over these the same as before for one-ninth the entire length of the threads. Pick up one group at the left and weave over these as before for one-ninth the entire length of the threads. Fill the six groups at the right with the blue thread to match the left side just finished. Fill the two groups at the center with yellow. Count off 14 more groups at the right and repeat from the beginning. Fill the threads between the two blue figures with yellow. Refer to the illustration when working.

Answers to Queries.
 Mrs. Mary C.—I believe it is possible to buy patterns of the heel and toe of a stocking; but unless these pieces are set in with the greatest care they would doubtless prove most uncomfortable.
 Miss H. P.—I think it would pay you to rip the hems on the bath

towels and put new ones in, making them a little wider and paying particular attention to the ends. Then your crocheted edging will be worth while putting on. One towel would make a fine gift and your friend is fortunate in receiving two from you.

Mrs. Clara: Why not use a single feather stitch—taking the smallest possible stitches—to outline your scroll design? The effect is good and it is a change from the plain outline stitch.
 Mrs. L. S. A.: I have mailed to you the directions for making beaded bags. Indeed, yes, many of them are beautiful, and if one has the time the work is interesting.

Homely Wisdom.
 A coarse grater is an effective utensil for scaling fish. Salt and vinegar will remove stains from teapots. Keep the hanging plants fresh and moist by putting a small funnel in the basket and filling it with water every morning. The more butter used in a cake the higher the temperature required to bake it. A wooden potato masher is an excellent utensil for creaming butter and sugar. White of an egg applied to a burn will exclude the air and prevent inflammation. Tomato rubbed into the hands will remove fruit stains. Hard water may be softened with borax, lemon juice or an oatmeal bag.
