SALADS AND MILK ADVISED AS FURNISHING VITAMINES

Dr. McCollum, Johns Hopkins University, Declares Butter and Cheese Will Do as Substitute.

ONE of the foremost authorities on vitamins, Dr. McCollum of Johns Hopkins University, Baltimore, says that if we will only eat a salad twice a day and drink a quart of milk, not necessarily raw, but in the form of dairy products, such as butter and cheese, we can get anything else we like and be sure of having obtained our full complement of vitamins which are so vital to our health.

One of the latest discoveries by this authority is that the humble, often much-despised cabbage (because of its comparative cheapness) in a raw state, is very high in vitamins, as it is rich in all three of these precious, mysterious substances. Raw cabbage contains two counts for vitamin A, one for B and three for vitamin C, which is the anti-scurvy one. Attention must be drawn to the fact that cooking the cabbage lowers the count of the first two.

Changes Now Common.

Truly the law of flux or continual change has been clearly established in the minds of most of us since the world war. No longer is anything fixed or set even in the food world. We must be prepared to give up our old favorites, and at a moment's notice right about face and embrace the new. If we want to keep well nourished and look as well as we are always claiming we feel.

It is only a few decades ago since we all believed that raw cabbage was highly indigestible for the human being, while it might be an excellent fodder for stock. Those of us who rather enjoyed it in a salad did so surreptitiously, feeling that we had plebeian tastes, or that we should apologize because we could not always afford the more aristocratic and high-priced celery.

Now all is changed in the salad world. We can use the lowly, cheap cabbage, even in our company salads, and if challenged by those who think celery is the only filler, and we can see that they secretly consider it more or less an affront to their importance to be offered cabbage—because we can assume a high-minded, up-to-date air and patiently explain the virtues of this vegetable, which we are studying and keeping abreast of the newest of the new in the vitamin world and feeding our family accordingly, even though the sacrifice asked for may be the substitution of cabbage for celery.

So if we want our children to be well nourished, with good teeth and firm, strong bones, we must give them milk and plenty of the leafy parts of plants. Lettuce, which we always use in keeping with our vitamin A, two for B, but none for C. Tomatoes have all three vitamins and none of the curative qualities are lost in the cooking.

Salad Salads.

1 can large sardines.
2 hard-boiled eggs.
Remoulade sauce to mix.
1 pint finely minced celery or cabbage.
1 cup olive oil.
1 head lettuce.
1 clove garlic.

Skin, bone and flake up the sardines and place in a mixing bowl. Cut the lettuce in half and add the clove of garlic. Add the potatoes and mix well together with sufficient

Child's Vigorous Growth Demands Candy

Sweets Should Be Consumed at Proper Time.

CHILDREN must have candy sometimes and their intense craving for sweets is natural and right. The vigorous growth of the little demands a generous allowance of sugar, but one should be sure the sugar is of the best quality and consumed at proper times. No child should be allowed too much sweets all day long; or to eat sweets so shortly before a meal that the appetite for other food is impaired.

The child should also have simple sweets rather than rich sweets. Cookies are better for hungry little folk coming in from school or play, than the sticky, sugary, luscious plain candies than the luscious chocolate bonbons that cost \$1 the pound and over. So long as the children like the sweets they will be satisfied and the longer they eat of acquiring a taste for rich sweets, the better.

There is a recipe for buttercream, easy to make and purer and more wholesome for the children than candy they may pick up at the shop on a corner. Level teaspoon of salt. Put in a saucepan a cup of granulated sugar, a tablespoon of lemon juice, a tablespoon of cold water and a tablespoon of butter. Boil without stirring until the mixture thickens in cold water. Pour into a greased pan and when almost set, score off with the back of a knife into squares. When cooled, the buttercream will be hard and brittle and the squares will break up easily. A dash of nutmeg gives a delicious flavor to the squares and may be added with the sugar.

Cookies that children adore are made with one cup of sugar, half cup of butter, one egg, one cup of flour, two teaspoons baking powder and half a teaspoon of milk. Add the beaten whites of the egg. Pat the dough thin, cut out and bake in greased pan.

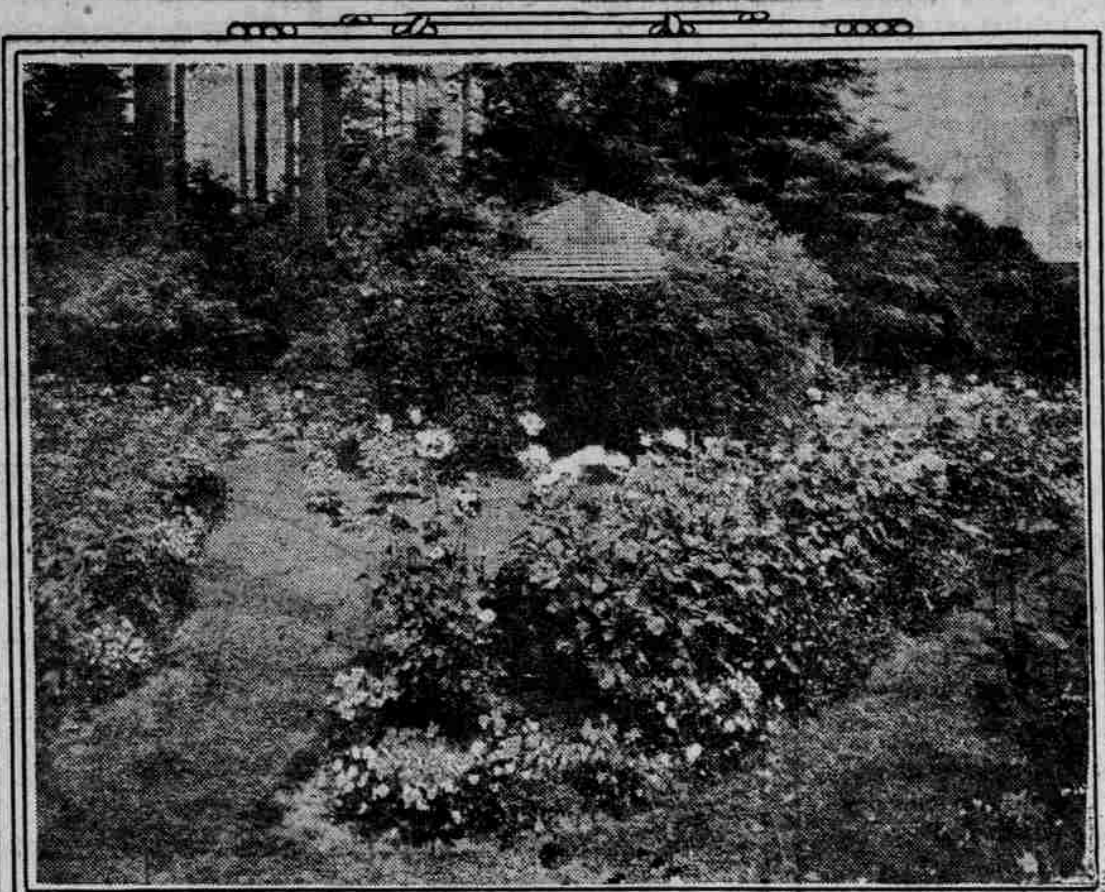

GARDEN to gain national reputation must have charm and such is the garden of Mrs. S. S. Montague, near the Portland Golf Club, at Raleigh station. That it has the necessary charm to demand national recognition is evident from the fact that a few months ago "The Garden Magazine," published in New York and the recognized authority on gardens, devoted two full pages to illustrating Mrs. Montague's garden, having selected it from all the gardens of the Pacific northwest as showing the most progress. That it has the charm necessary to win such recognition is evident from the fact that Mrs. Montague can testify, for in it you can find almost any plant you may desire and they have been so arranged and grouped so as to bring them all out in their greatest attainments.

It has been my good fortune on a number of occasions to take visitors to Portland to see Mrs. Montague's garden, and these visitors have endeavored to coin some phrase which will suit it, some calling it a "charm garden" and others a "soul garden," but to me it is an "individualistic garden," for on every hand you will see something which shows the enthusiasm and designed. Possibly I am led to give it that name because I know that it is an individualistic garden, a thing about it, every plant and shrub, every curb of the walks and every rock in the rockery, has been selected with the most careful attention to the coloring and the well-kept appearance of the garden.

Every line and curve in the garden and every bed has been planned by Mrs. Montague and once I asked her how she succeeded in getting such irregular yet natural curves. Her answer was so practical that it may aid some amateur gardeners. She said: "I take the garden hose, lay it along the turf and then pull it here and push it there until I get the curve which I think suits the place and then I mark along the hose and I have my curves." Such practical things as this do not reach the ears of the average gardener, but the care and attention each plant receives, together with the charm it exercises as a whole, is why I say "Arrow-wood" is an "individualistic garden."

According to reports being received, the rose trials in the famous Bagatelle gardens in Paris this year are a failure, and if Portland will only seize the opportunity it can within a year make the International Rose Trials in Washington and London park as world famous as have been the Paris gardens for the past 20 years, for from the common knowledge of the gardeners of this city, it is not difficult to select this garden as illustrating garden progress in the northwest.

In speaking of this garden, Mrs. Montague said: "I have been in the garden for 16 years and I am short when we come to reckon in nature's terms, a country field has been transformed into lovely sweeps of lawn and colorful bloom—an effect very English in character, but the garden is not a copy of the English garden, it is a fitting western landscape. A species of spiraea from all through the woods gave 'Arrow-wood' its name and the garden is a garden in itself, gracefully to garden conditions in the role of background for the perennial border."
