Improved Demand for Mohair Reported.

MUCH TRADING RECORDED

Conditions Declared by Expert to Be the Healthiest Since July, 1914.

Increased activity in the mohair mills and an improved demand for mohair are outstanding features on the English mohair market according to advices received from S. B. Hollings of Bradford, England, mohair expert and British correspondent of the Angus Journal.

A new chapter has opened and the initial outlook is certainly good. The trade has followed largely in the wake of other businesses and its recovery from the depression of the war years has taken time.

From 25,000 to 25,000 bags of mohair have been sold in Bradford during the first six months of the current year, which sales of mohair have been considerable, and run into several thousands of bales. Stocks are plentiful in reasonable compass and largely in the hands of actual consumers.

There is a strong factor and should be pleasing to Angola goat breeders both in South Africa and the United States.
