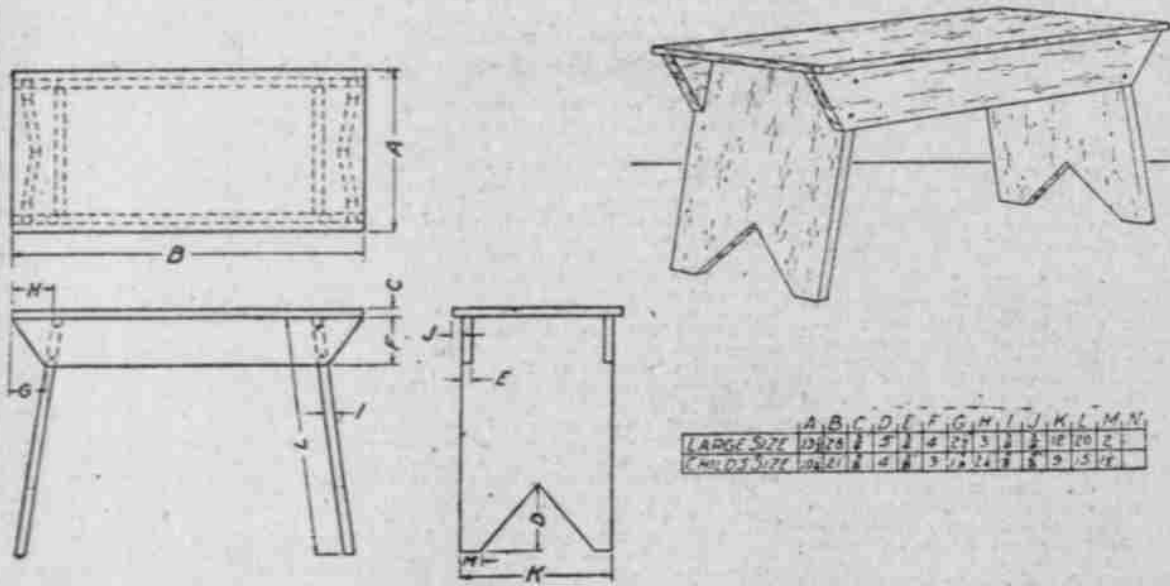

#### HANDY PLAY OR WORK BENCH



"By nature, man likes to produce," says Roger W. Babson, famous statistician and business adviser. "Give a boy a knife—you do not have to show him how to use it. He instinctively begins to make a bow or an arrow or perhaps something he has never seen. Why? Because in his soul there is an inherent joy in production. The salvation of our industries depends on the discovering of something which will revive in man that desire to produce and that joy in production which he instinctively had when he was a small boy."

AN ARTICLE that is useful to all the family is valuable. What could be more useful around the home than a bench that little sister or brother can use to play and make things on, that mother can use in any number of ways, that dad can use as a footstool or that can be found handy for numberless other purposes? Here we have directions for making just such a bench.

If the finished bench is painted, most any light wood will do. Make the top first. If you choose to make the bench large in size, instead of small, follow the dimensions given in the scale for that size shown in the drawing. If you want to make the bench smaller—I call it the child's size—follow the dimensions given in the lower section of the scale. If the top cannot be made in one piece, join two pieces of wood together. Join them with a dowel joint.

The ends, too, may be made of several pieces. After they have been squared up and planed make the cutouts to receive the stretchers—those long boards running the length of the bench on the side.

Next, lay out and cut the Y in the bottom of each leg. If you have a turning, or coping saw, this cutout can be changed to any other shape you want.

Your next step is to make the stretchers. Determine just how much slant will be given to the legs before you cut the angles on the stretchers. It is not desirable that the legs project beyond a plumb line dropped from the top of the bench to the floor.

When all the parts have been cut assemble them, using nails or screws. If you choose nails use 2 or 3 penny finishing nails. Screws

make the finished piece stronger. Round-head 1 1/2-in. No. 18 screws used to fasten the stretchers to the legs add to the appearance of the bench. To keep the wood from splitting bore a 3/16-in. into the stretcher for each screw. A smaller hole should be made in the leg to receive the screw. Make this by driving in and then pulling out a finishing nail.

Sandpaper all parts so there are no rough surfaces. Round all the edges and corners so they are not sharp.

I suggest that you paint the bench a light gray or straw color. Decorate the edges of the top, ends of the stretchers and edges of the design cut in the legs, with a very light blue. It will be a pretty piece of work.
