FRAZZLED JUSTICE.

When twelve reasonably intelligent men hear all the evidence in a criminal case, listen to the argument of able counsel, and then deliberate upon the credibility of witnesses, the merits of the evidence, the motives which prompt testimony both pro and con, and then bring in a verdict, that verdict should stand, unless new evidence, of almost wholly revolutionary character, should obtain.

In the noted Lee rape case, there has been no new evidence brought to light. The old stereotyped objections to the testimony; all the doubtful points as to whether a conviction should follow; and the weak points in the case, are all that the defense could build as a foundation for a pardon, and these were thoroughly reviewed at the trial. Able counsel carried the case to the supreme court, where the decision of the lower court was confirmed. For months and months, the case dragged its weary trail over the ramparts of law and decency, after the two courts had passed upon its merits. Then a sympathy racket is commenced. A sleek story, and one that received no possible credence at the trial, was poured into the ears of a lenient public, (to parents whose daughters had not been raped) and a petition was secured and sent to the chief executive of the state.

The executive has pardoned the offender! One can understand how a murderer can be given a pardon, especially when the animus of the crime was a crazy wrath, but where is the mantle of charity that covers the vesania that prompts the pardon of child rape? Where is the moral? Of what use are our courts? Of what use are statutes for the protection of child virtue? What filthiness of soul can possibly prompt a man to set aside the verdict of two courts in a case like this? Is it moral conception of low order, or is it politics figuring in the case? This pardon is an invitation to brute beings to turn loose the poison of their lust on the bloom of childhood and turn the purity of child life into living hell!

Washington county should be proud of Governor Geer, and Governor Geer should be proud of himself—that the powerful agency of Washington county's chief attorney can override the decision of fact, and the statutes provided for protection of helpless female children.

OREGON'S NEXT CAMPAIGN.

Oregon's next political campaign gives promise of an interesting political fight, and the richness of the whole thing is, the high political premacy in the state. The campaign is headed by the scion of Judaism, the junior senator, the Hon. Jos. Simon. There are many republicans in the state who believe that Simon reached his goal through methods that will not bear scrutiny, and they are right when they assert that the "Jaquy" could not possibly have been the choice of the people. These republicans, and the most of them are removed from the effects of Multnomah county politics, feel that the state has been betrayed, and they are now laying the groundwork for a revolution. They intend to elect George McBride to succeed himself, and they are starting in early. The dervishes under the auspicious Jew, however, are whetting up their spears to combat the Yamhill, George to a Japanese finish, and the conflict will be eagerly watched. Tongue, who is a McBride man, if the truth be known, is to be laid on the ice box, and a new man substituted, a man who will stand with the Multnomah bank and lawyer senator. If Tongue

is not beaten at the primaries it will be a close call. Simon now has Moody and he wants one more aide. If Mr. Tongue will stultify himself, and go over bodily to Joe's camp, he may be allowed to eat his pie unmolested. Otherwise he must fight the fight, and, if nominated, watch out for long and keen knives. Joe is out for perpetuity and he always removes obstacles. He cut the political entrails out of Corbett, his supposed friend—his avowed friend—and is it unreasonable to prophesy that he will beat Tongue, who always opposed him secretly, if not openly? So, we are going to have a lively time next spring. The dems and pops are all in the woods, and they can have it all their own way. The republican ticket should get plenty of votes, anyway, for Geer will soon have the penitentiary emptied. There is something in mutual obligation.

WHY THEY ARE SILENT.

The silence of the debased and cheap product advocates at the present time has its significance. But a few months ago they were clamoring for a more thorough "gold basis" and a "scientific banking system." This demand did not come from the agricultural supporters of the administration, but from the bankers' association and large credit holders. So, the word has gone out that no more must be said about "currency reform" and they trust to again betray the agricultural vote. All they want is to "name the men" and they will get their measures into law.

They are not going to again ruthlessly vote to debase that which they produce, for the benefit of a few dollar holders. The American farmer and 50 cent wheat legislation are too much enemies for to allow money contractionists their own way. Fear of this causes the silence.
