'Maggie' is the dam of 'Lord Lovelace,' 2:10, contending horse in a race 2:06; 'Portia Knight,' 2:16 1/2, contender in a race, 2:12 1/2; and 'Ben Bolt,' record to a wagon, 2:18, trial, 2:11. 'Maggie' is sired by 'Duroc Prince,' second dam, 'Frankie' by 'Oregon Pathfinder,' sire of the dam of Alto, 2:09 1/2, and 'Pathmont,' 2:09 1/2, the sire of 'Pathmark,' 2:11.

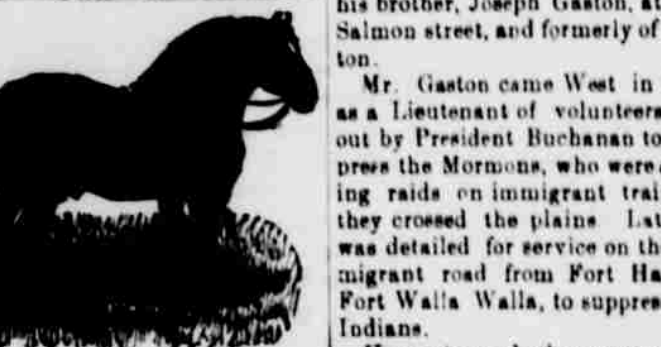
