F. R. Davis, of the North Plains, was in town yesterday.

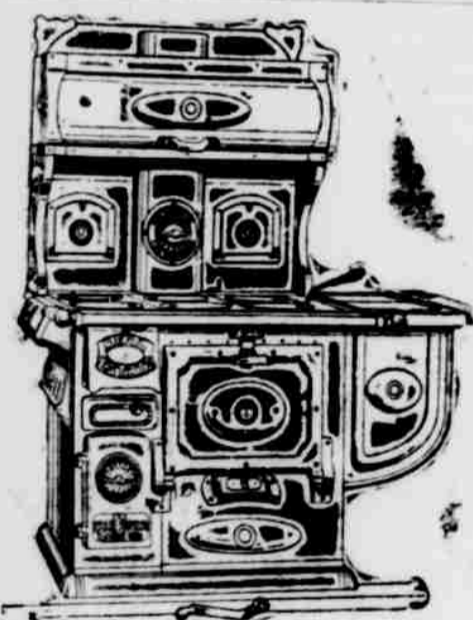
The fair and box social held by the ladies of Manning, last Saturday evening, was well attended. The school house was beautifully decorated for the occasion, and the receipts were \$56.60.
