**THE FAIR EXHIBITS**

Hillsboro and vicinity did itself proud in the exhibition at the street fair which closed Saturday night. The livestock show was better than last year; the poultry show could not have been better; and the horse exhibit was superb but the crowning glory of all was the demonstration made by the fruit growers. For the first time in the history of exhibits the apples displayed were put into proper shape for inspection, and the exhibits were all that anyone could ask for in the most favored apple district the world can give. The exhibits were perfect in form, color, freedom from scale or parasites, and visitors for the first time could see the latent possibilities in apple culture. The growers who made exhibits evinced the proper public spirit, and the manner in which the splendid fruit was shown up for inspection found approval in the minds of all. Mr. Alexander, of the Board of Trade, struck the keynote of success in the way he handled the wonderful demonstration of what old Washington county can do in this line. The public spiritedness of the stockmen who lent their aid to the fair is to be highly commended, and the owners of the vegetable and poultry exhibits have no less esteem for their support.
