## WHY IT IS CALLED THE PEAK OF GALES

Named After First Ship Builder in Great Northwest

BUILT THE STAR OF OREGON

Sailed it to San Francisco and Sold Vessel at That Port

There is hardly a point in Washington County, where you gain any eminence, that you cannot see Gales Peak, in the coast range, beyond Forest Grove. Aside from a few pioneers who know the story, there are few who know "why" it is called Gales Peak, or why Gales Creek is so named.

Away back in 1836 one Joseph Gales, from New England, went West to St. Louis, and joined a furhunting expedition. He made the Pacific slope with his companions, and in 1841 built the first sailing vessel in the Northwest. This was called the Star of the West, and in 1841, after launching the boat near Swan Island, below Portland, he sailed it to San Francisco, where he sold out. Taking the proceeds he and his fellows bought livestock and sheep, and brought them back overland to Oregon where there was said to have existed a "beef trust," Gales subsequently settled on Gales Creek, and stream and mountain peak were given his name.

Later he went to Lake Wallowa, Eastern Oregon, where he died, years ago. Gales was a close personal friend of Col. Joe Meek, Senator Nesmith, Dr. McLough-

lin and other pioneer notables. When hereafter you look toward the blue hills of Gales Creek you can think of the old soldier of fortune who has left his name commemorated in the geography of Washington County. Gales built the first flour mill in this county, and he operated it with an overshot wheel. In the olden days, the North Plains farmers carried their grists to Gales Creek to get their flour ground. The Harrison mill, built later on Dairy Creek, near the present Oak Cove farm, owned by Geo, R. Bagley, finally took the most of that trade away from the Gale mill and it was abandoned.
