FEDERAL JURORS

Out of sixty federal trial jurors called to report in Portland, April 10, Washington county was called upon for eight. One, P. S. Anderson, of Reedville, is in British Columbia, while two of the panel, N. W. Chilcott and C. B. Buchanan are members of the circuit court, March term, for the county. Mr. Buchanan, however, was a grand juror, and has been discharged. Those drawn from Washington county: P. S. Anderson, Reedville; Sherman Bacon, Forest Grove; Wm. Bagley Sr., Leisyville; E. H. Last Thursday night some rascal broke into the barn of John W. Jackson, Glencoe, and stole 24 Angora fleeces, which had been clipped but the day prior. The wool weighed 90 pounds, and the vehicle carrying the stolen nanny-lace was tracked to Portland. The thief had sold the product to Metzger, the Portland buyer, about two hours before Sheriff Hancock reached the place. Mr. Jackson went down and identified the fleeces, but the thief was not to be found. It is thought that Portland parties committed the theft. The theft constitutes grand larceny, as Angora wool is now selling at 32 cents, making the value of the stolen wool \$28.80.

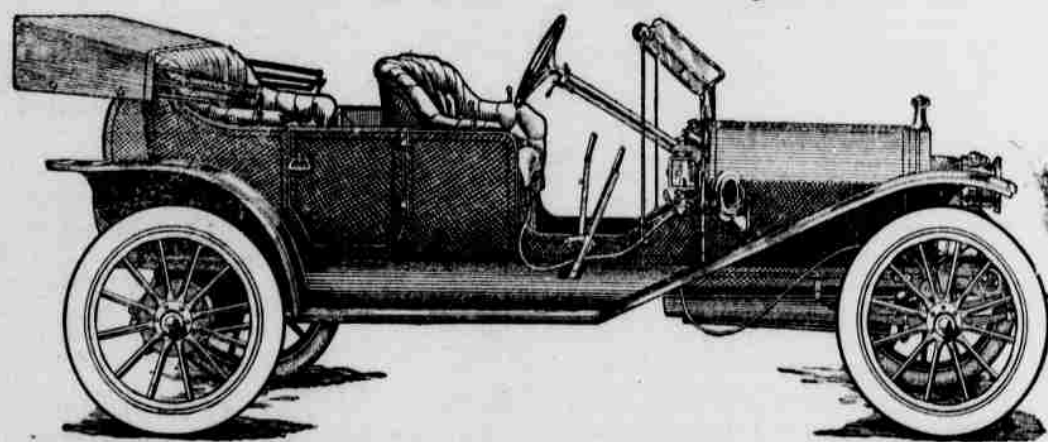
