

NOTICE OF SANITARY SEWER APPOINTMENT.

Notice is hereby given that the City Engineer of Hillsboro, Oregon, has filed in my office his estimate of the total cost and expense of constructing and laying down sanitary sewers and laterals inside and outside of the Sanitary Sewer District No. 1, and constructing a septic tank for an outlet to said sewer, all as set forth in Ordinance No. 249 of the City of Hillsboro, Oregon, establishing a sanitary sewer district in the city of Hillsboro, Oregon, prescribing the time and manner of constructing and laying down a sanitary sewer and laterals inside and outside of such district for constructing a septic tank for an outlet, and providing that the costs and expenses of such improvements shall be apportioned to and assessed upon the property benefited thereby, passed by the City Council and approved by the Mayor of said city on May 31, 1911, which estimate amounts to the sum of \$41,515.27, and said City Council has apportioned and is about to assess upon each lot, tract or parcel of land benefited thereby, in said district, its share of such entire cost and expense, as follows:
