The Southern Pacific is asking for a franchise on Main Street, and the town is full of argument, pro and con. There seems to be no particular opposition from those who own property on Main. That is to say a majority evidently want the line. On the outside, however, there are many who wish the line to take other streets. The company, on the other hand, asks for Main, and say they will have none other. It is now up to a sort of deadlock, and it does not appear as though a franchise will be granted. It will be settled next Tuesday night, and no one should lose his temper if it be granted, and no one will lose any sleep if the Southern Pacific elect to remain down in the warehouse district with its line, provided the franchise is refused.

Hillsboro's tragedy, Monday, was one that touched the common heart. Two lives were lost, and weighed against the property sacrificed, the latter has no significance. The firemen complain of water shortage, but it appears that the lives would have been lost in any event.
