## MRS. AMBROSE SMITH ASKS \$15,000 ALIMONY

Sues Her Husband, Tualatin Mill Man, for Divorce

**BIG SUM FOR SUIT MONEY, ALSO**  
Complaint Embracing Seven Pages, Filed in Circuit Court

Mrs. Vienna Smith, of Tualatin, wife of Ambrose D. Smith, a Tualatin sawmill man, has sued her husband for divorce in the circuit court, asking for \$15,000 in cash to prosecute the action, and for \$15,000 permanent alimony. Her complaint sets out many abuses by the husband. Smith is interested in the Tualatin Mill Company, and the wife states that he owns a \$30,000 interest, worth at least \$30,000. She asks for an injunction against Smith selling or transferring the property until the suit for separation is settled.

Mrs. Smith alleges that the husband has been negligent, and that he has prevailed upon her to cook for a logging crew, and live on an unhealthy saw, and that her health has suffered therefrom. She says that he allowed her to visit the Lewis & Clark Fair but a portion of one day, while he made frequent trips to the scene of festivities. The complaint also charges that the husband displayed too much affection for another woman. The case will come before the term of court which convenes next Monday morning.
