

This advertised list of delinquent taxes for the year 1911 is in pursuance of an act of the State Legislature, which is entitled in chapter 22 of the GENERAL LAWS OF THE 1911 SESSION.

The taxes on the following described real property situated in Washington County, Oregon, became delinquent on April 4, 1911, and are subject to the penalty of 10 per cent and interest at the rate of 12 per cent per annum until they shall have been paid. Any tax may be paid after expiration of the delinquency period, but the penalty and interest shall be paid in addition to the tax.
