ROCK WILL ROLL IN AFTER THE FOURTH

Many Road Districts Will Begin to Macadamize Highways at Once

NEWTON ROAD TO HAVE ROCK LAID

County Court Will Rush Work in all Districts With Levis

Rock will next week begin pouring in all along the railway lines where road districts have special levies, and the county court has made arrangements to rush the work as rapidly as possible.

Road District 6, South Hillsboro, will lay rock from the city limits toward Newton, and this will mean a good road where there has always been hard traveling in the wet season.

In the Banks section some rock will be laid on some bad stretches, and all in all several miles of rock road will be laid before the Fall rains set in.

Tualatin, where Commissioner Nyberg resides, also has a special tax, and operations are to begin there at once.
