

COUNTY COURT ISSUES HILLSBORO PROHIBITION

Case Will go to Trial, However, Circuit Court, December 1 SHERWOOD INJUNCTION WAS GRANTED

The county court Monday issued the prohibition order for the City of Hillsboro, shortly after Judge Campbell ruled that he would not sign the temporary injunction restraining issuance of the county court manifesto.

Attorney Geo. R. Bagley, of Bagley & Hare, counsel for Wiley, stated that the legality of the election would again come to issue about Dec. 1, and he then expected sufficient evidence to win their case.
