## COUNTY BOARD NAMES LIST OF 300 FOR JURY

Men Selected From all Points of the County for Service in 1914

ALL MUST BE NAMED ON TAXROLL

Forest Grove and Hillsboro Have Largest Selections—No Women

The county court has had some struggle in selecting names for a panel from which the jury for the circuit court will be selected for the year 1914.
