J. A. BAKER AWARDED CONFISCATED LIQUOR

Court Signs Order Directing Sherill to Turn Over Lot of Whiskey

LAST CHAPTER OF A GASTON RAID

Liquor Ready to be Surrendered Upo Call of Plaintiff

Circuit Court has awarded several parcels of whiskey to J. A. Baker, of Gaston, on whose place a raid was made by the state of. ficials some months ago. The decree gives Mr. Baker an order to recover a fifty gallon barrel full of whiskey; 10 or 15 gallons in a fifty gallon barrel; 20 galons of Blackberry Cordial; 2 barrels full of quart barrels of "My Maryland" whiskey, and a barrel about two-thirds full of quart bottles of whiskey, the bottles not being labelled.

The liquor has been in the custody of the sheriff for months and months, and is ready to be orned over upon demand. Baker pleaded guilty to the charge of elling liquor at the time the case came to trial, after confiscation, and he paid \$500 on one infictment, and was fined \$50 on ach indictment from No. 2 to No. 19, with 30 days on each offense, the fines and jail sentences having been suspended during good behavior.
