Law Compels Him to Levy Upon Chattels-Take Possession and Sell

REFUSAL BY SHERIPF MEANS FINE

Liable to \$1,000 Fine if Official Does so do His Duty

Sheriff Reeves will start the collection of tax on personal property next week. The laws says:

"On or as soon as practicable after the first day of September in each year the sheriff shall proceed to collect all taxes levied in his county upon personal property which have not been paid before said day, together with penalty and interest thereon, He shall levy upon sufficient goods and chattels, belonging to the person, firm, corporation or association charged with such taxes, if the firm can be found in the county, by taking them in the county, by taking them into his possession, to pay such delinquent taxes, together with interest, accruing interest, penalties and all other lawful taxes, and shall immediately advertise such goods and chattels for sale by posting written or printed no-tices of the time and place of sale in three public places in his county not less than 10 days prior to such sale, etc."

The law also provides that the

tax can be charged against real property owned by the same parties, and such tax, after charging, shall become a lien. The sheriff who refuses to fol-

low the law is liable to indictment, and upon conviction may be punished by not less than \$100 nor more than \$1000 fine, or by imprisonment of not less than six months nor more than six

years—which is some penalty.

So no person can justly complain if the sheriff seeks to evade and avoid either the fine or im-

He can also be charged 10 per centum damages and 12 per centum interest, and this is col-lectible upon the officer's bond. There are hundreds of people on the roll who have not paid their personal tax.
