Notice of District Road Meeting to Vote Additional Road Tax in District No. 45

We, the undersigned resident tax payers of Road District No. 45, Washington County, Oregon, together comprising more than ten per cent of the resident tax payers in said road district, hereby give notice that a meeting of the resident tax payers of said Road District No. 45, Washington County, Oregon, is hereby called, and will be held at Heister's School house, in said Road District No. 45, Washington County, Oregon, on the 21st day of Nov., 1914, at the hour of 2 o'clock P.
