## BUDGET MEETING ASKS REDUCTION

### Seventy Thousand Advised Stricken From Estimate

### STANDS AT OVER QUARTER MILLION

### Six Mills for Road Fund to Cover Machinery and Oil

The county court Tuesday heard the budget meeting's consideration of the proposed tax estimate. Judge Reasoner presiding. There were about 100 present, and the assembly advised a reduction of about \$75,000 from the total, leaving the general tax at \$272,129, as against the proposed \$347,491.

The items submitted and advertised, follow, with the reductions, or action, following each:

Estimate of Expenditures Required for the Year 1914.

County Road Fund (For Roads and Bridges) \$120,000.00  
Road Machinery 21,000.00  
Road Oil 10,500.00  
The last two items, a total of \$31,500 were voted down, the first item standing.

This was reduced in the sum of \$2,900, but the law will govern the amount to be paid, in a large measure.

Those items were given a reduction of \$1540.

The above was reduced \$1500, leaving the appropriation \$5500.

Both these items were voted from the budget.

A reduction of \$1620 was voted on this budget.

These items are allowed to stand as submitted in the budget.
