JURY FINDS HASKELL
GUILTY OF CLIPPING
Forest Grove Young Man Tried in
Circuit Court for Offense
COURT SUSPENDS HIS SENTENCE
Charged With Cutting Curl From Young
Woman, at Movie Show

William Haskell, a young man
residing in Forest Grove, was
Monday found guilty of assault
in circuit court, the complaining
witness being Mrs. Roy Dilley,
formerly Miss Annie Freeman.
Miss Freeman charged that one
evening last Summer, while she
was attending a motion picture
show, Mr. Haskell sat behind
her, and clipped a lock of her
hair, using a jack-knife for the
purpose. Haskell was arrested
and taken before Judge Smith,
and bound over to appear in cir-
cuit court. The jury was out
but a few minutes, and brought
in a verdict of guilty. The de-
fendant, however, was recom-
mended to the mercy of the
court. Judge Campbell suspended
sentence during good behavior.
Young Haskell has always borne
a good reputation, and Geo. Han-
cock, J. A. Thornburgh, Carl
Hoffman, J. G. Shearer, John
Wagner and others testified to
his good conduct and general
good reputation. The jurors,
however, refused to consider
Haskell's denial of the act, but
appeared to feel that he was en-
titled to leniency.

prosecuted the case, and H. T.
Bagley defended. The jury:

E. Miller was sentenced to pay
\$50 fine for giving liquor to a
minor. He paid the cash.

State vs Henke—same charge;
fined \$50 and costs, or 25 days in
jail in default of payment. Jail
sentence suspended and de-
fendant given time on payment
of fine—to pay in five monthly
installments, beginning Febru-
ary 1. He is also to remain out
of saloons, and will have to re-
port every month to Sheriff
Reeves as to his whereabouts
and his behavior.
