 Notice is hereby given that the City Council of Hillsboro, Washington County, Oregon, did on March 12, 1915, pass a resolution declaring its intention to improve Main Street from the West line of Sixth Street to the East line of Tenth Street, in the City of Hillsboro, Oregon, in the manner following to-wit:
