IN THE CIRCUIT COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON FOR WASHINGTON COUNTY.
C. B. Woodworth, Plaintiff vs.
W. H. Cox and Paul Reimers, Defendants.
In the name of the State of Oregon, I am hereby required to appear and answer the complaint filed against you in the above entitled suit, at or before six o'clock of the date of the first public hearing hereof, to wit: on or before six o'clock of the 30th day of July, 1915, and if you fail to answer, or fail to appear at the public hearing, or if the plaintiff will apply to the court for the relief demanded in the complaint, the court will decree the relief requested in the following described real property situated in Washington County, State of Oregon, to wit:
Beginning at an iron pipe at the center of Section Eleven, 11-1, Township Three, 3-S, Range 12E, 2W, West, Will, Mer.; Thence South 65° 2' West, Will, 181.0 feet, along the line thereof to the center of section 2 on an iron pipe, thence South 65° 2' West, Will, 127.37 feet to an iron pipe, thence North 13° 57' West, Will, 95.13 feet to a stone; thence easterly, following the line of a chain contract dated July 27th, 1911, between Western Fuel Co, a corporation and defendant W. H. Cox, and terminating the amount due the plaintiff within which defendants or either of them may determine, and fixing a time pay into court for the plaintiff, may be found due, together with the amount for costs, and within which plaintiffs may either direct or consent to the closing of all right, title, interest and equity, and that the plaintiff do have and costs and disbursements, and for such other and further relief as may be just and equitable.
