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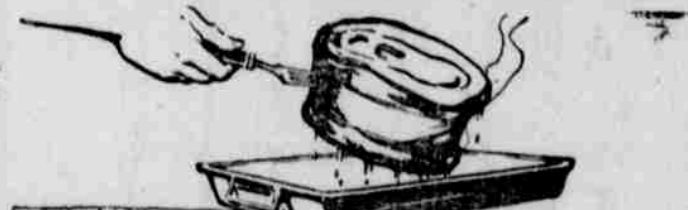
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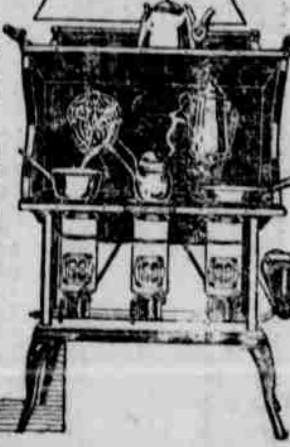


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NOTICE OF SHERIFF'S SALE

Notice is hereby given that by virtue of an execution, decree and order of sale issued out of and under the seal of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon, for Washington County, dated the 19th day of April, 1916, in a cause therein pending wherein M. H. Strosser is plaintiff and Carl A. Kampe and Ida E. Kampe and George Fred are defendants, and wherein judgment was rendered in favor of the plaintiff and against the defendants Carl A. Kampe and Ida E. To Alvin H. Rule, above named defendant:

In the name of the State of Oregon, you are hereby required to appear in the above entitled court and cause on or before Friday, June 16th, 1916, at the said date being 15 days next after the date of the first publication of this summons and notice; then and thereafter to appear and answer or otherwise plead to the complaint filed against you in the above entitled cause, and if you fail to do so a decree will be taken against you for want thereof for the relief demanded in said complaint, to-wit: For a decree dissolving the marriage contract existing between the plaintiff and the defendant, which shall be an absolute divorce, and for such other and further relief as may seem just and right.

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NOTICE OF SHERIFF'S SALE

Notice is hereby given that by virtue of an execution, decree and order of sale issued out of and under the seal of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon, for Washington County, Oregon, on the 22nd day of May, 1916, in a cause therein pending wherein the defendant to the plaintiff (dated October 20th, 1914, recorded in book 73, page 116, records of Washington County, Oregon) upon the following property to secure the payment of an amount of \$2800 be foreclosed, to-wit:—beginning at the quarter section point between sections 2 and 3 Township 2 South Range 1 West of W. M. running thence South 54 degrees East 234 chains; thence North 50 degrees 30 minutes East along line between Lots 30 and 31 in North Tigardville Addition 8.97 chains to Graham Avenue; thence along Graham Avenue to a point in the extension of a line between lots 27 and 28 of said Addition, being 2.99 chains more or less; thence South 39 degrees 53 minutes West 8.97 chains more or less to the place of beginning, containing 2.64 acres, being the east part of lot 31 in North Tigardville Addition according to the recorded plat thereof, in the office of the recorder of conveyances of Washington County, State of Oregon. That said mortgage be decreed to be the mortgage of the defendant and a purchase price mortgage upon the above described parcels of land, that said mortgage be foreclosed and the property sold in the manner provided by law and that the proceeds arising from said sale be applied first to the payment of the costs and disbursements of this suit and the cost and expenses of making sale and the remainder thereof be applied to the payment of the claim of the plaintiff, on account of principal, interest and attorney fees and that any balance thereafter remaining be paid to the defendant, her heirs and assigns. That the plaintiff may become a bidder at said sale and that the defendant and all persons claiming by or through or under her shall have expired by and forever foreclosed of and from all equity of redemption in or to said property. And that the plaintiff may have such other and further relief as is meet in the premises.
