JUDGE H. M. CAKE IS PORTLAND OPTIMIST

Tells Realty Board That Oregon Will be all to Good Henceforward

OF INTEREST TO COUNTY PEOPLE For Reason That There are Millions in Our Lumber Deposits

Judge H. M. Cake, lawyer, republican, and hail-fellow-well-met, was for Mr. Hughes in the recent contest, and, from time to time, it is presumed, pictured some supposedly bad results in case Woodrow would beat Mr. Hughes. At a meeting of the realty board, the other day, Mr. Cake had something to say. For the reason we have millions of dollars worth of timber in this county it is worth repeating:

"Right now the banks are full of money, and the farmers are so well off that they, too, are loaning capital. Why, do you know, in timber alone we have a resource of \$400,000,000 reckoning it at \$1 a 1000, and when sold as finished products it will be worth many times that. "The Panama Canal has finally been built to give us ready access to the markets of the world. As soon as the big conflict is over, our lumber will go to every mart, just as it would now be going were it not for the war.

"In the last 24 months the shipbuilding industry has been born and reared in this community, and it has already brought \$22,000,000 worth of business.

"After years of fighting we now have 40 feet of water at the mouth of the Columbia River, and a 30 foot channel to the sea, so that the greatest vessels in the world may come to us."
