WILSON GETS FINE OF TEN THOUSAND

Greatest Fine Ever Imposed in
Circuit Court, Friday

SENTENCE SUSPENDED ON CONDITION

Must Leave State For Period of Two
Years, or go to Jail

Circuit Judge Geo. R. Bagley on Friday imposed a fine of ten thousand dollars on James Wilson, who pleaded guilty to abducting his son, who was given into the custody of Mrs. Wilson. On October 24, Wilson kidnaped the little boy while he was playing on the streets near the home of his grandparents, Mr and Mrs. Jed Nichodemus. Sheriff Reeves located Wilson and the boy on the Sandy, a few days afterward, and he was brought to the county jail, the boy being restored to his mother. The grand jury indicted Wilson, and he pleaded guilty and accepted sentence. Wilson's parents live in Iowa, and they are willing to send him the money to return to that state. The money is expected here this week, and meantime Wilson has been held here pending the arrival of funds.

Had the parents not been willing to finance Wilson's trip to the East it would have meant a jail sentence of one day for every two dollars of the sentence. This would have meant 5,000 days in the bastille, or 13 years and 11 months incarceration.
