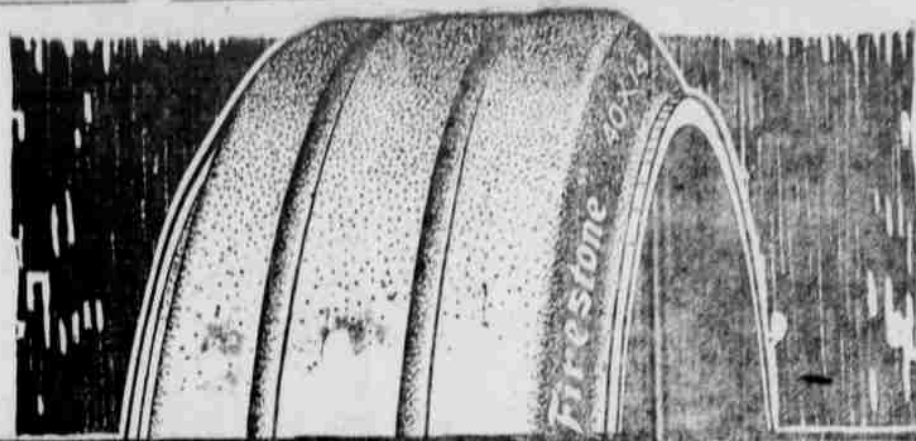

The Music of "Victory Day"

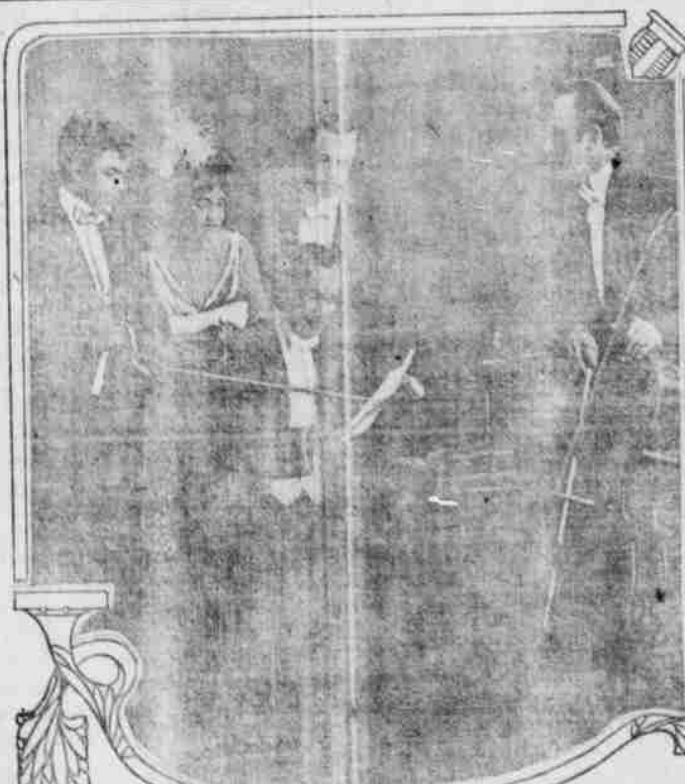
The Overseas Quartet Coming to Chautauqua With Two Great Programs

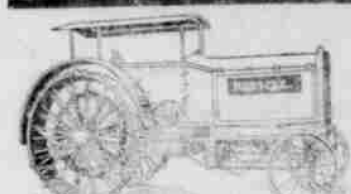
