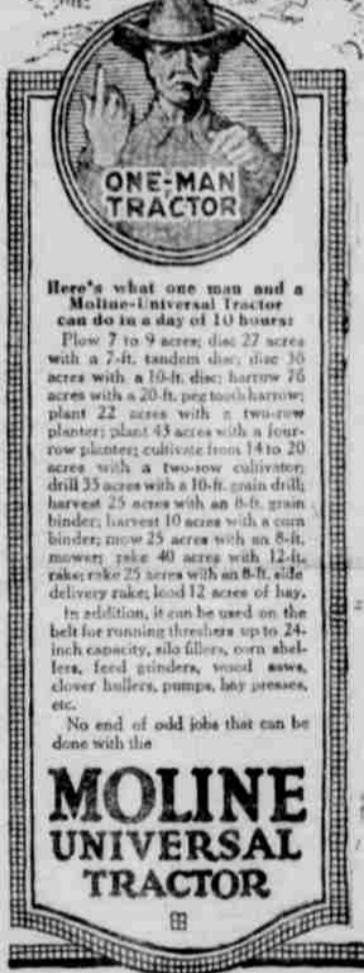
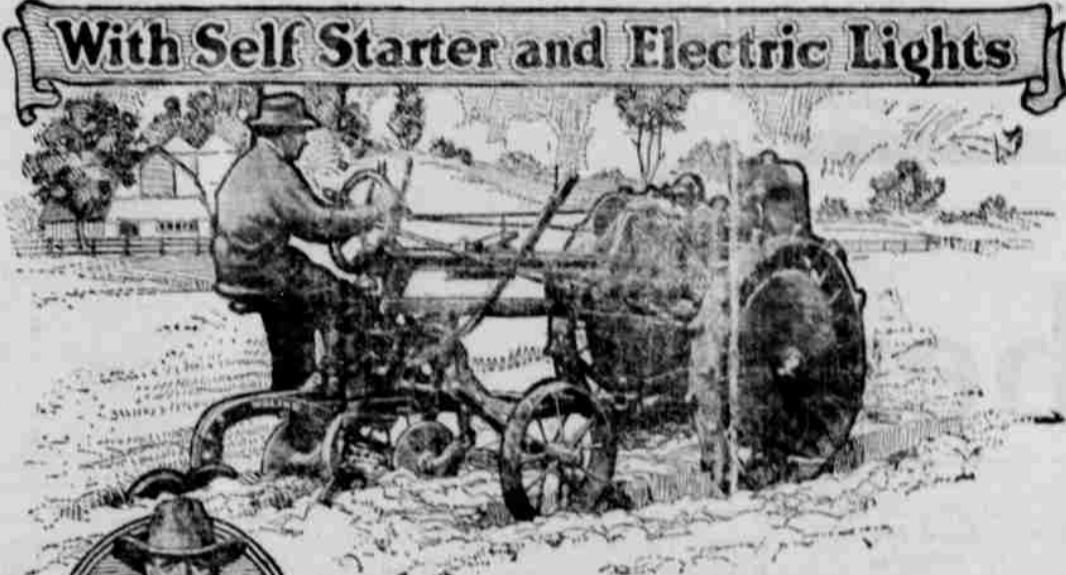


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Three Plow Results Two Plow Expense

Pulling two plows under average conditions at 3½ miles per hour the Moline-Universal Tractor will plow 9 acres a day, as much as the ordinary three plow tractor can do. It will do as much work as tractors from 1500 to 2000 lbs. more. Lighter weight gives greater economy of operation and no packing of the soil.

But the amount of plowing the Moline-Universal will do is only one of many great advantages. You sit on the plow, not on the tractor. You are in the best position to observe the work that is being done, and for adjusting your plow. You can back right up into a fence corner, plow out headlands, and turn short. You are away from the heat and vibration of the engine.

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
