The man had \$25 in cash. He cultivated his berries, kept his family, picked his crop, paid the owner of the land one-third of the crop, paid his debts and put \$1200 in the bank.

This is not an exceptional story, merely the common run of what any man can do who will work and cultivate a tract of small berries in Western Oregon or Washington.

Thousands of additional acres of loganberries, raspberries, blackberries and strawberries must be planted to fill the demand which is growing faster than production. If we don't supply the market we have created, somebody else will. There is no time to lose.—Oregon Manufacturer.

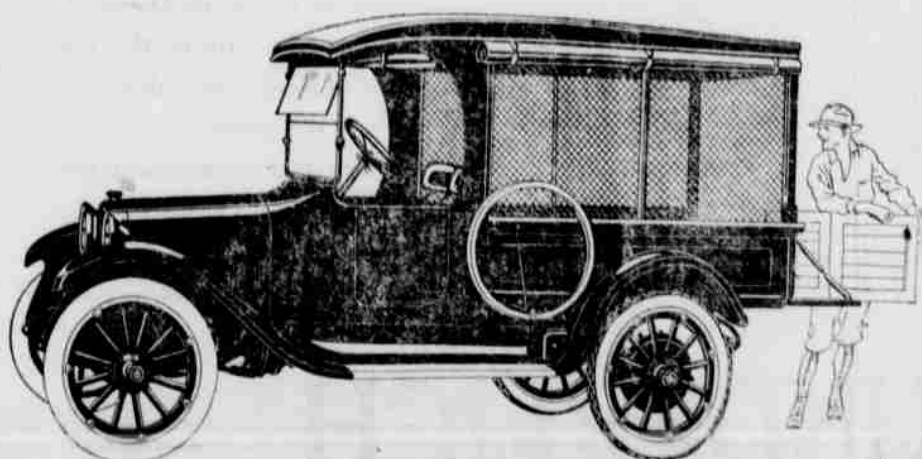
