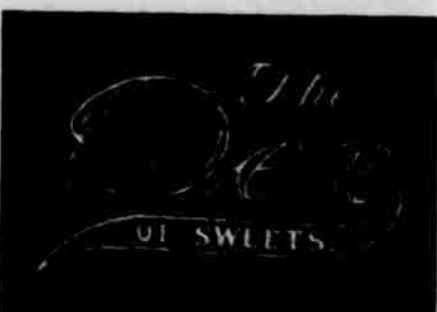

STEAM SHOVEL HERE

The steam shovel bought by the County of Washington has arrived from the East, thirty days or more late, and the huge machine is being unloaded and installed to the south of the city, where it will be worked in putting in a long fill at the south approach of the Jackson Bottom bridge. Land has been procured on each side of the trestle, and the shovel will put in the sides from the borrow pit and fill in the center from earth along the county road at the Rosecrans and Lisco places. The shovel already has months and months of work ahead, and it will put in many fills which will supplant the trestles wherever it is humanly possible to get along without a bridge.
