#### Wheat Exports Are Less

During the month of September, 1927, 6,911 carloads of wheat were inspected at Portland by the department of the state market agent's office, while during September of this year only 2,776 carloads were

inspected, but the condition of the grain is better this year. In September, 1927, 2,563 carloads, or 37 per cent, were smutty, while this year only 525 cars, or 19 per cent, were so reported. The total exports of wheat out of the Columbia were 9,744,046 bushels for September, 1927, while this year for the same month they were 3,846,580 bushels. For July, August and September, 1927, exports were 15,046,252 bushels, and this year 8,053,930 bushels.

One cup of molasses in a recipe is the equivalent of one-third cup of sugar and one cup of liquid. One egg equals one-half teaspoon leavening agent. If one cup ground nuts is used one-third cup less butter is required. Three tablespoons cocoa equal one square of chocolate.

Cheese and soda crackers are often served as a last course at dinner. Roquefort, Camembert or Neufchatel cheese is especially desirable at this time. It may be cut

in small squares and served on small plates with a butter spreader.
