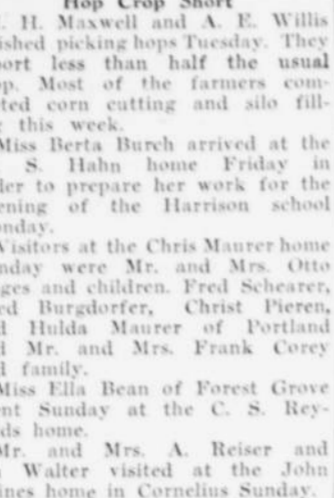

Hebrews Praised In Church Address

"No other people, in the face of persecution and misunderstandings, have ever made a contribution to the moral and spiritual in our civilization as have the Jews," said the Rev. Prof. J. Feunega, formerly of Pacific university, Forest Grove, in an address advocating a more tolerant attitude toward their Hebrew brethren, given Sunday evening at the family gathering in the Congregational church. Professor Feunega substituted for the Rev. Gordon H. Windsor of Portland, who had been scheduled to speak on young people's work, but who was prevented from appearing. Mr. Feunega pointed out notable examples of Jewish leadership, from the days of Abraham, through Jesus of Nazareth, continuing to such modern examples as Dr. Selling, Justice Brandeis of the United States supreme court, and Governor Julius Meier.

All the Sundays of September will see the 6:30 p. m. family gathering continued with Dr. Raymond B. Walker, pastor of First Congregational church, Portland, speaking next Sunday, and Dr. C. H. Harrison, state superintendent, closing the series of guest speakers on September 27. A social hour, with refreshments, will mark each of these gatherings, which are held in the lower rooms of the church.
