A pamphlet issued by the Millbank Infantile Paralysis commission described a typical case as follows:
"A child that has been well becomes restless or drowsy. He is feverish, irritable and doesn't want to be moved. He is apt to vomit once or twice and may complain of headache or pain in the back. or in the back of the neck. He is likely to be constipated, but may have diarrhea. More significant are a sore, stiff neck and spine and pains in the back, arms and legs."

Paralysis may not develop to within 24 to 72 hours, and the extent does not depend upon how sick the child was in the early stages. The greatest opportunity for help is before paralysis develops, but it is at this time more difficult to detect. Even a physician specialist may find it necessary to draw fluid from the spinal column before he can be certain that it is infantile paralysis.

No preventive drugs may be bought as a protection, and it is only in certain cases, and under the direction of the medical doctor that a "convalescent serum" can be used to help prevent paralysis developing in those who have been discovered in the early stage.
