I believe that public officials and employes receive greater pay for their services than the pay of our farmers

I desire to see Oregon benefitted in every way possible in connection with the construction of the Bonneville Dam but I do not believe this is the time to burden the State of Oregon with a great bonded indebtedness until it is definitely determined what we may expect from the Federal Government in the distribution of electrical power and energy in the State of Oregon generated at the Bonneville Dam, bringing to every manufacturer, every city dweller and every farmer its benefits on equal terms.
