Use of pasture grasses for the control of soil erosion as well as for supplying a permanent pasture for livestock is of growing importance in agricultural practices.

Thirteen types of pasture grasses are being grown in trial plots on the Guerber farm. These grasses are: Astoria Bent, Reed Canary, Upland Canary, Meadow Fescue, Kentucky Blue grass, English Rye grass, Domestic Rye grass, Orchard grass, Timothy, Tall Oat grass, Chewing Fescue, Tall Fescue and Smooth Brome.
