Work Relief Payroll Huge Over County

Government Puts \$125,000 Among Unemployed Here Since September

Sponsors Give Help Local Political Units Add \$61,412.98 to Total

Expenditure of approximately \$196,000 for work relief projects in Washington county since WPA began operations last September...

Of the total amount reported, \$63,495 was spent for materials used in construction by the various units of government sponsoring the projects...

The remainder, \$132,505, was furnished by the federal government for payrolls to persons formerly on the relief rolls of the county.

Thirty-six projects were undertaken in this county since WPA first was instituted September 26 of last year...

Considerable of the total has been devoted to repair, remodeling, or new construction of school buildings in all parts of the county...

County roads also have received considerable of the expenditure...

The largest project listed for the entire period being a road project using \$176,934 for materials furnished by the county...

Other projects are projects carried on in Washington county since last September and the amount of money furnished by the federal government and the local sponsors...
