Unemployment Story Cockeyed; Babson Says Industry Normal

(By Roger Babson) BABSON PARK, Mass.—Several weeks ago I announced that business had reached "normal" according to my Babsonchart.

First, let me briefly explain the Babsonchart. Periodically, my statisticians add together by means of a special formula, the physical number (not the dollar value) of freight cars loaded, pairs of shoes made, automobiles assembled, etc.

This index, therefore, shows the average output of all industries and in all sections of the country. What I say "normal" means that all industries are doing a normal business.
