Fingerprints Identify Rice as Alleged Burglar

Fingerprint records carefully taken by Deputy Sheriff Harry Johnson following numerous burglaries in Washington county and Hillsboro, led Wednesday, to an alleged confession by George Rice, 19, Hillsboro boy.

Rice was captured by Portland police after a chase when he attempted to holdup a Portland filling station Wednesday morning. He is said to have gone to Portland in a car stolen from Dr. Rex W. Wilson of Forest Grove Tuesday night.

Faced with the fingerprints, Rice is said to have admitted that he twice entered the Coslett filling station buildings, robbed Busch's filling station of \$55 and the Bailey service station of \$15 and a wrist watch, and was in a car at the Texago station in Beaverton.

Other burglaries in other counties are charged to him and he is said to have confessed stealing four local automobiles.
