## Contest Rules

1. Any reputable girl (unmarried), between the ages of 18 and 30, inclusive, living in Washington county is eligible to participate in this contest. Employees of or relatives of Argus employees are excluded, but correspondents of or relatives of correspondents of the Argus are eligible.
2. Credits for new subscriptions and renewals will be awarded to contestants in accordance with the accompanying table when cash is turned in. All contestants must report all collections for the past week to the Argus office each Wednesday before noon. Contestants not complying with this rule will be subject to a deduction of 10 per cent in credits in all subscriptions not reported on time. Contestants will be directly responsible for all subscription money collected and will remit in full promptly.
3. Credits are not transferable. Credits may not be bought but will be awarded only on paid-in-advance subscriptions reported.
4. Subscribers renewing or starting new subscriptions may earn credits on such subscriptions by designating at the time cash is paid the candidate to whom the credits are to be awarded.
5. Contestant having the highest number of credits at the close of the contest will be adjudged the winner of the nine-day all-expense trip to California and old Mexico. Additional cash prizes may be added later at the discretion of the management.
6. Active candidates who do not win the prize trip or any of the cash prizes, that may be announced later, but who remain active throughout the six weeks of the contest will receive commission checks of 10 per cent on all subscription cash they turn in. To be regarded as active a candidate must turn in at least two one-year paid-in-advance subscriptions each week during the contest, starting the second week.

STARTING APRIL 3, 1937

**SATURDAY**—Leave Union Station, Portland, Southern Pacific "Klamath" 8:40 A. M. All meals that day in diner.

**SUNDAY**—Arrive Oakland Pier 7:13 A. M. Cars switched to southbound train. All meals in diner. Arrive Los Angeles late evening. Sleepers switched to Santa Fe train.
