Safety for Pedestrians

Pedestrian lanes would be established on Baseline at the intersections of First, Second and Third avenues, one lane to an intersection.

Tenth Stop Street

Stop signs would be placed on Baseline at Tenth avenue, making this intersection a stop from both directions on the state highway.

Parking Changed

Method of parking on Main also is slated for a change from parallel parking to angle parking between First and Second on both sides, and on Second between Main and Lincoln on both sides.
