Beginning at a point on the south city limits of the City of Hillsboro, half way between the center of South Fifth and Sixth Avenues extended and running thence North to the center of the block bounded by Fifth, Sixth, Walnut and Cedar Streets, thence west 3 blocks, thence north ½ block to the center of Walnut Street, thence west ½ block to the center of Second Avenue, thence north ½ block, thence west ½ block, thence south ½ block, to the center of Walnut Street, thence west on Walnut Street one block to the center of the block between First Avenue and the Center of the railroad on Adams Avenue, thence north along the center of the blocks between First Avenue and Adams Avenue to the north city limits of Hillsboro, thence west 1 block to a point midway between Adams Avenue and North Connell Avenue extended north, thence south through the middle of the blocks between Adams Avenue and North Connell Avenue and this northerly extension to the center line of Main Street, thence continuing south ½ block to a point midway between Main Street and Washington Street, thence west midway between Main Street and Washington Street to the western city limits of Hillsboro, thence southerly along the westerly city limits to the S.
