

League Women Voters Urges Registration

Importance of every citizen registering by April 16 in order to vote in the primaries in May was stressed by the Washington County League of Women Voters' meeting at Forest Hills Golf Club Monday.

All citizens, the league holds, should assume their duties of citizenship by voting.

A large group of women heard Miss J. Vergeer, resident nurse of the migratory farm labor camp at Dayton, describe the camp and explain how it functions.

Main purposes of these camps, which are a project of the Farm Security Administration, U. S. Department of Agriculture, are as follows: First, to provide temporary housing, sanitary, health and social facilities for part of the thousands of farm family workers engaged in seasonal and specialized crop sections.

Second, to provide more efficient service for grouping of seasonal labor through grouping of workers and routing them through a representative of the Federal Farm Placement Service.

Third, to provide a stepping stone from farm laborer to eventual farm ownership for a limited number of disestablished farm families forced into seasonal labor for a livelihood.

Miss Vergeer was introduced by Mrs. L. L. Hervey, Forest Grove chairman of government and economic welfare committee.
